Waste

Solid Waste Reduction and Reuse

Yield maximizing software and techniques are used to minimize the amount of raw materials used in our process. This enables lower amounts of material to be used and recycled.

Recycling

We are using Second Chance to donate our fall off (scrap wood) when building our wooden containers. We will donate approximately 7,500 lbs of wood that will not be going into the waste stream. This wood will also be repurposed for DIY'ers and contractors in Baltimore.

In our corrugate manufacturing area, we are going to be recycling over 55 tons of corrugate. This resource will be recycled for future uses.

Energy

Energy Efficiency

To help reduce our natural gas needs, we installed low-velocity high-output fans to assist in destratification. This savings is estimated to be about 17% of our annual gas consumption.

Our warehouse lights have been updated so that motion sensors limit the amount of time that the lights are on.

Lastly, we have installed smart thermostats to better control the heat consumption of the facility and offices.

Transportation

Fleet Vehicles

Currently, our drivers are managed on idle time, acceleration, and stopping. These three components are a direct correlation to fuel efficiency. We use Fleetmatics to monitor these and many more attributes to reduce our fuel consumption.
