GES is a certified installer of Kingspan Thermomax solar collectors, which are 85% efficient throughout the year and designed to assist in providing the domestic hot water needs of both residential and commercial end users.

At GES we recycle paper, aluminum cans, and plastic bottles. These are items used or consumed in our facility on a daily basis. Though we are a small organization, we do what we can on an individual basis every day. In addition to daily consumables, we also recycle the old water heaters we take out of the customer's home during the installation of their new solar thermal system.

Efficient Business Travel

In an effort to reduce some fuel costs, we have decided to have all company meetings via Skype. This is a free teleconferencing service you can download from the internet. If you consider that the average distance from any given employees home to the office is 22 miles, we have 4 employees, the average mpg on our trucks is 16 mpg, and that we meet bi-monthly; you can see that we save at least 96 gallons of fuel each year. Though this is not a staggering figure, every little bit does make an environmental impact.
