In 2008, we formed the Miller's Minuteman Press Green Team. Comprised of company representatives from all levels of the organization, we meet quarterly to discuss and assess our policies and procedures to ensure we are operating in an environmentally friendly manner. All or employees are encouraged to suggest green ideas and alternatives.

Environmental Restoration or Community Environmental Projects

Miller's Minuteman Press is a proud partner of Trees for the Future. Since 1989, Trees for the Future has been helping communities around the world plant trees. Through seed distribution, agroforestry training, and country programs, they have empowered rural groups to restore tree cover to their lands. Via our

Waste

Recycling

On average, we recycle 3 tons of paper per month, so on an annual basis, we are saving:

We use vegetable and soy based inks and our direct-to-plate presses have greatly reduced the silver and chemical solvent usage.

We encourage our employees to be energy conscious by ensuring computers and machinery are in 'sleep' mode when not being used. We use lower wattage bulbs and request lights are turned off accordingly. We group projects ensuring optimal running of our equipment.

We have implemented a conference bridge and encourage teleconferencing wherever possible. We plan deliveries and pick ups according to the most efficient routes to consolidate trips and avoid unnecessary travel.
