Our main objective is to synchronize green infrastructure within outdoor living spaces to create landscapes that serve multiple functions for our client's lifestyles as well as the local ecosystems.

In 2022, our team planted over 2,000 native plants in Southern Maryland. We hope to plant double that in 2023.

Each of our services is designed to transform your outdoor space into a beautiful and sustainable landscape. We offer everything from landscaping and hardscaping to stormwater management and buffer mitigation. Our designs are made to reflect your lifestyle and we use carefully chosen, native hardy plants and flowers to create stunning spaces that allow the surrounding ecosystem to thrive.

Inspired by natural spaces, our signature design approach creates timeless low-maintenance landscapes that utilize beautiful native species. We design spaces to match your lifestyle and simultaneously provide ecological function.

Our company specializes in designing and installing residential stormwater systems. With every design, we aim to reduce the amount of runoff on our client's property and manage the stormwater sustainability by implementing any one or multiple of the following systems: rain garden, bioswale, step-pool, infiltration berm, permeable pavers, etc. We've installed 15 stormwater BMPs since 2020.

Whether the county requires a commercial or residential stormwater BMP, or you are looking to enhance your property's infiltration capabilities to do your part, we are certified to design and install stormwater BMPs.

☑ Environmentally Preferable Purchasing

We purchase shredded hardwood mulch from a local vendor. The debris used to make the mulch is local to our area to make sure to not introduce or spread invasive species. All aggregates are purchased from local vendors who obtain them from our local environment. We source our plants from local growers.

☑ Environmental Restoration and Community Environmental Projects

From restoration as small as monarch butterfly habitat to the complex biodiversity and functionality of a stream or buffer. We are certified to design and restore ecosystems.

All yard debris removed from our client's properties is either burned and converted into compost or shredded into mulch to then be reused at other sites.
