All our departmental management is continually looking for ways to improve our green footprint. We meet as needed to discuss new ideas and communicate internally via email & text message to evaluate the changes that are being made. Management then educates their departments on the policies and practices so that all staff are working together towards the same sustainability goals.

Annual Environmental Goals

Our inn uses Public Good brand Toiletries, refillable packaging made by 100% recycled post-consumer plastic bottles to reduce plastic waste. Their products are also made with organic ingredients and no toxic chemicals to reduce grey water levels. Since the switch, we no longer throw away 902,400 mini toiletries bottles a year. We evaluate our energy, water, and waste utilization each month and make adjustments to reduce our impact as needed.
