## **TRAINING PROVIDERS**...

Our next training provider meeting will be held in the Aeris Conference Room at MDE on March 5, 2014, from 10 a.m. to noon. Now that we have several months of third-party testing under our belts, we would like to get your input on how this change in the testing process has affected our training providers. Bring to the meeting any questions or problems the training providers have come across concerning the Ramirez Bill.

If you had your training <u>before October 1, 2013</u>, and lost or had your photo ID card stolen, you can come to our office at MDE on the first or third Tuesday of the month and get a replacement card. This procedure will continue until September 2, 2014. After this date, we will not provide this service. Students will only be able to obtain a new Maryland Photo ID card by first taking the third-party exam, passing the test and then having the photo ID mailed to you.

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## Contractors' Corner....

As many of you are aware, the Department has been administering the third-party asbestos exams for all those who have completed their asbestos training after Oct. 1, 2013. Since our January testing dates needed to be cancelled due to inclement weather, we expect a large turnout for the February dates. We recommend that you pre-register to ensure a seat for a future exam. We have scheduled the exam dates through April. We appreciate your patience during the transition. To pre-register you need to mail, NOT hand deliver, the following to our P.O. Box 2037:

1). Registration form completed and signed,

2). Copy of Training Certificate (Bring original to exam for verification).

3). Payment: \$60.00 per person/exam in the form of a check, money order, certified check, or cashier's check, (NO Cash). Make checks or money orders payable to "Maryland Clean Air Fund." You must submit the paperwork at least 10 days in advance of the exam. By following these directions registration will go smoothly for the test takers.
