
Greenhouse Gas Reduction Act Timeline



A report submitted by the Department to the Governor and General Assembly that includes:

- A summary of the State's progress toward achieving the 2020 emissions reduction required by the plan (MDE).
- An update on emerging technologies to reduce GHG emissions (MDE?).
- A review of the best available science regarding the level and pace of GHG emissions reductions and sequestration needed to avoid dangerous changes to the climate (UMD).
- Recommendations on the need for science-based adjustments to the requirement to reduce statewide GHG emissions by 25% by 2020 (UMD, MDE).
- A summary of additional or revised regulations, control programs, or incentives that are necessary to achieve the 25% reduction in statewide GHG emissions (ALL).
- The status of any Federal program to reduce GHG emissions and any transition by the State from its participation in RGGI (MDE).
- An analysis of the Plan's overall economic costs and benefits to the State's economy, environmental and public health (MDE).
