CSU October & November 2014 OBD II Anomalies Class

The **FREE** training class “**OBD II Anomalies**” will be taught by Jim Kemper and Randy Bernklau of Colorado State University on Saturday October 11th and Monday October 13th and again on Saturday November 8th and Monday 10th. These are 4hr classes and all class sessions cover the same material. The times, dates and locations are as follows:

This would be vehicles that don't follow normal OBD II testing and/or diagnostic routines. Some general course topics are: Brief background of OBD requirements, A review of various changes over the years by CARB of the OBD rules, A list of known vehicles with a history of testing and/or repair problems, and Review of Maryland data related to those issues.
