

**PUBLIC NOTICE OF A RESPONSE ACTION PLAN  
AND PUBLIC INFORMATIONAL MEETING**

EMERSUB 16 LLC (fka Kop-flex)

The properties located at 7555 and 7565 Harmans Road in Hanover, Maryland have been accepted into Maryland's Voluntary Cleanup Program. A proposed response action plan (RAP) has been submitted to the Maryland Department of the Environment (MDE) for approval. The property's soil and groundwater have been affected by solvent chemicals, primarily chlorinated volatile organic compounds. The proposed response actions involve the implementation of institutional and engineering controls, and operation of hydraulic containment systems to control migration of contaminants in the groundwater. The contaminated groundwater will be collected and treated to remove the contaminants, and the treated water discharged to a nearby surface water body.

This RAP is based upon future use of the property for commercial purposes.
