FACTS ABOUT: METALS AND RESIDUES PROCESSING SITE

Site Location

The former 1.606-acre Metals and Residues Processing Company is located at 4400 Milford Mill Road in Pikesville, Baltimore County. The industrial zoned site can be found on Baltimore County tax map 0078 as parcel 0756.

Site History

Little information is available in MDE files for the former Metals and Residues Processing site that was located at 4400 Milford Mill Road. According to available files the main activity at this site was reclamation of precious metals from circuit boards with potassium cyanide or nitric and muriatic acid. The spent solvents were removed from the site by a chemical recycler. The domestic wastewater was discharged into a septic tank and then removed by a local septic hauler.

The property was used as a private shop and garage by Howard Snyder from 1960 until 1976. In mid-1976, the garage was leased to Metals and Residues Processing Co. In January 1981, the site was sold to the Maryland Transit Authority which occupied the site until sometime after 1989. This site is currently, or has been occupied by Milford Automotive Center, C&S Towing, Guardian Basement Waterproofing, Guardian Security and Surveillance and Slade Auto Body.

Environmental Investigations

MDE completed an Environmental Priorities Initiative Preliminary Assessment on March 12, 1990. Since there are no records of spills and no physical evidence of hazardous waste or materials remaining at the property, MDE recommended “No Further Remedial Action Planned” status under the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation and Liability Act.

Current Status

MDE has no further requirements for this site at this time.



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
