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EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

During Calendar Year 1995, Maryland operators produced 3,629,531 tons of coal. Surface coal mine production was 780,961 tons-- 633,185 in Allegany County and 147,776 in Garrett County. Deep coal mine production was 2,848,570, all in Garrett County.

During calendar year 1995, two new permits were issued and 9 permit amendments were issued. One hundred thirty-five acres were permitted.

Two hundred fifty acres were affected, 230 acres backfilled, and 229 acres planted. Bond was released on 480 acres. Four permits were completed, with bond being totally released.

One thousand seventy-three inspections were performed on coal mining operations. Eight Notices of Violation and 15 Cessation Orders were issued. Forty-four Citizen Complaints were received and investigated.

The Land Reclamation Committee met 8 times and approved 9 reclamation plans. The Committee also evaluated the revegetation on 249 acres eligible for Phase II bond release and approved 186 acres as meeting the standards for release.

During 1995, grants awarded to Maryland by the U.S. Department of Interior, Office of Surface Mining, provided \$1,771,189 for the reclamation of abandoned mine lands. Approximately 89 acres of abandoned mine lands were reclaimed.

Functions and Duties of the Committee:

The Land Reclamation Committee is responsible for the approval of all reclamation plans submitted, as part of an application for a permit, to the Bureau of Mines and for the oversight of land reclamation activities on surface coal mining operations in Maryland.

The Land Reclamation Committee visits proposed and active mining sites to:

- (1) determine the suitability of the proposed reclamation plan;
- (2) review the annual mining and reclamation progress; and
- (3) evaluate the success of the revegetation practices.

During 1995, the Land Reclamation Committee conducted site visits on 8 days. These visits included field reviews of 9 proposed mining sites, 27 revegetation planting reports, and 2 special field visits.

The Land Reclamation Committee conducts meetings to:

1. Review and approve reclamation plans;
2. Review reclamation progress on active mining permits;
3. Evaluate the revegetation on areas eligible for Phase II bond release;
4. Review the surface coal mining laws, regulations and policies and recommend changes to improve effectiveness of the Maryland Regulatory program; and
5. Recommend research and cost-sharing projects to promote optimum revegetation of surface coal mined lands.

During 1995, the Land Reclamation Committee met 8 times. During these meetings, the Land Reclamation Committee approved 9 reclamation plans, evaluated 249 acres of revegetation eligible for Phase II bond release and approved 186 acres as meeting the standards for release.

FOR THE CALENDAR YEAR 1995
REVEGETATION OF SURFACE MINED LANDS

A permittee must submit a backfilling and planting report to the Bureau of Mines after planting is completed. When this report is approved by the Bureau, a minimum bond liability period of five years begins. All reclaimed permit areas may have bonds reduced (Phase II) after two years, and totally released (Phase III) after five years from the approved planting date. The Phase II bond may be released when:

1. The revegetated area is not contributing suspended solids to stream flow or runoff outside of the permit area in excess of the requirements of the regulatory program;
2. All temporary drainage control structures are removed and the affected area is regraded, seeded and mulched; or all permanent structures are inspected and any deficiencies are repaired;
3. With respect to prime farmlands, soil productivity has been returned to the level of yield required;
4. Revegetation has been established in accordance with the approved reclamation plan and the standards for success of revegetation have been met; and

When all of the above requirements have been achieved, a longer evaluation time may still be required if the health conditions of the revegetation are questionable. The Phase III bond on an area may be released when the permittee has successfully completed reclamation operations in accordance with the approved reclamation plan, achieved compliance with the requirements of the regulatory program, and the applicable liability period has expired.

Bonds cannot be released until the required work is completed, the appropriate evaluation time has elapsed, and the permittee submits a complete application for bond release to the Bureau. During 1995, the Bureau released Phase II bond on 186 acres, Phase III bond on 140 acres, and totally released bond on 11 permits.

In January of each year, a listing of acres eligible for Phase II and Phase III bond releases during the calendar year is compiled and available from the Bureau of Mines.

FOR CALENDAR YEAR 1995
ABANDONED MINE LAND RECLAMATION

The Maryland Bureau of Mines administers two programs to reclaim and/or restore land and water resources adversely affected by past coal mining practices. These two programs are: (1) Maryland-Federal Abandoned Mine Reclamation Program, implemented utilizing Federal funds available under the Federal Surface Mining Control and Reclamation Act of 1977 (U.S. Public Law 95-87) under the authority of Environment Article, Title 15, Subtitle 9 of the Annotated Code of Maryland, and (2) Maryland Mine Reclamation Program implemented utilizing funds from the Bituminous Coal Open-Pit Mining Reclamation Fund (BCOMRF) under the authority of Environment Article, Title 15, Subtitle 5; the Deep Mining Fund under the authority of Environment Article, Title 15, Subtitle 6; and the Mine Reclamation and Water Quality Restoration Loan under the authority of Environment Article, Title 15, Subtitle 7.

Maryland - Federal Abandoned Mine Reclamation Program

The Maryland Abandoned Mine Land Reclamation Plan received Federal approval on July 16, 1982, thus enabling Maryland to receive Federal funds for the reclamation of abandoned mine lands. During 1995, grants awarded to Maryland by the U.S. Department of Interior, Office of Surface Mining, provided \$1,771,189 for the reclamation of abandoned mine lands. Approximately 89 acres of abandoned mine lands located in Allegany and Garrett Counties, Maryland were reclaimed during the 1995 calendar year.
