Notice of Application Received and Informational Meeting

In accordance with Sections 1-601, 1-602, and 1-603 of the Environment Article, Annotated Code of Maryland, the Maryland Department of the Environment (the "Department") is presently reviewing a Refuse Disposal Permit Application submitted by Severstal Sparrows Point, LLC for the construction and operation of the proposed Sparrows Point Works Industrial Waste Landfill. This landfill, a nonhazardous industrial waste acceptance facility, is to be located next to the existing Greys Landfill between Bear Creek and Peninsula Expressway in Sparrows Point, Baltimore County, Maryland.

Notice is given that the Department will hold an Informational Meeting regarding this application at 6:30 p.m. on January 20, 2011 in the Sparrows Point High School (Auditorium) located at 7400 North Point Road, Baltimore MD. In case of inclement weather, the Informational Meeting will be held on January 27, 2011 at the same time and in the same location. The purpose of the Informational Meeting is to provide an opportunity to the general public to obtain information about the permit application and the Department's review process. Representatives for the applicant and the Department will be available to answer specific questions.

Upon prior request, an interpreter for the deaf or hearing-impaired persons will be provided. The application and supporting documents will be available for public review at the Baltimore County Public Library located at 1716 Merritt Blvd, Baltimore MD 21222 and at the Department by appointment **after January 5, 2011.**
