Application materials are considered public information once submitted. They should not include private or privileged information. Application materials will not be returned.

#### Completed application materials should include the following items, in this order by May 1:

- 1. Completed application form
- 2. Copy of 12<sup>th</sup> grade Quarter 1 and Quarter 2 report card or transcript
- 3. Two recommendation letters from a teacher or advisor. One of the recommendation letters must be from a teacher in the school's Science Department.
- 4. A minimum 200-word essay regarding an environmental project that he/she participated in or developed.
- 5. Copy of college acceptance letter
