

POLICY: PLANTING ON DAMS (UTILIZED AS A ROADWAY)

The Dam Safety Division has recently adopted a policy allowing limited plantings on dry stormwater management structures to accommodate landscape planting requirements under the following conditions only:

- 1. Planting may only be on top of the dam along the sidewalks.
- 2. The top of the dam shall have a minimum of 50 foot top width.
- 3. Planting will not be allowed on the side slopes.
- 4. Plantings will not be allowed within the buffer zone (15 feet from the toe of the dam).
- 5. Planting may only be shallow rooted trees or shrubs.
- 6. The pond is a "dry" structure (normal pool not exceeding 18 inches).
- 7. A landscape plan shall be submitted showing type and location of planting prepared by a Landscape Architect certifying shallow rooted plants (less than 3' deep).
- 8. A minimum of 3 feet freeboard above the 100-year water surface elevation must be maintained.
- 9. The structure is a low hazard (Class "a") pond.
