County: Frederick
FR1939G048/08: Lehigh Cement Company LLC has applied to to increase an existing appropriation from an annual average of 4,000,000 gallons of groundwater per day (gpd) and an average of 4,800,000 gpd during the month of maximum use to 5,000,000 gpd and 6,000,000 gpd respectively. Water is used for non-contact cooling water at the Union Bridge cement plant and is withdrawn from the flooded inactive quarry lake located at Maryland grid coordinates Northing 628.5 & Easting 0750. The project is located south of the cement plant located in Union Bridge, Carroll County, on the north side of the inactive quarry (old quarry lake), Frederick County, Maryland.
County: Queen Annes
QA2016G005/01: Richard Weaver has applied to appropriate and use an annual average of 10,300 gallons of groundwater per day (gpd) and an average of 20,600 gpd in the month of maximum use. Water will be withdrawn from six wells in the Aquia aquifer and used for a poultry operation using evaporative cooling pads. The project is located at 2502 Barclay Road, approximately two miles east of Barclay, Queen Anne's County, Maryland.

SM2016G004/01: St. Mary's County Metropolitan Commission has applied to appropriate and use an annual average of 170,000 gallons of groundwater per day (GPD) and 255,000 GPD in the month of maximum use for the Charlotte Hall community water supply. The water will be withdrawn from one well in the Upper Patapsco Aquifer. The project is located at 37770 Golden Beach Road, Charlotte Hall, St. Mary's County, Maryland.

WI2016G015/01: Porter Mill Properties, LLC has applied to appropriate and use an annual average of 67,800 gallons of groundwater per day (gpd) and an average of 412,200 gpd in the month of maximum use. Water will be withdrawn from one well in the Columbia aquifer and used for crop irrigation. The project is located on the north side of US Route 50 at its junction with Porter Mill Road, approximately 0.5 mile north of Hebron, Wicomico County, Maryland.

WO2016G009/01: Harry Pearson has applied to appropriate and use an annual average of 76,000 gallons of groundwater per day (gpd) and an average of 462,000 gpd during the month of maximum use for crop irrigation. Water will be withdrawn from one well in the unconfined Pocomoke aquifer. The project is located at 8515 Harmon Landing Road, Newark, Worcester County, Maryland.
