(Must be delivered within 60 days from the end of the monitoring period in which Lead AL was exceeded)

Exceed Lead Action Level

Non Transient Non Community Water System

Lead Public Education Program Requirements

- Review [Lead Public Education Instructions](#)
- Mandatory water bill statement
- Deliver notification to water system customers and newspapers
- Deliver pamphlets and/or brochures to facilities and organizations frequently visited by high risk groups
- Contact local public health agencies
- Identify and deliver materials to daycare centers, preschools and obstetricians-gynecologists and midwives
- Implement at least one activity from EPA's "[Outreach Toolbox](#)"

Lead Public Education Program Requirements

- Review [Lead Public Education Instructions](#)
- Deliver EPA mandatory form and notifications to all water system customers
- Post informational posters in all buildings served by facility

To be repeated at least once each year until AL is no longer exceeded

Within 10 days of completing the Lead Education Program send the MDE Water Supply Program copies of all education materials and the completed [Certification Form](#).
