County: Charles

CH2017G006/01: Dominion Energy Cove Point LNG, LP has applied to appropriate and use appropriate and use an annual average of 176,000 gallons of groundwater per day (gpd) and 230,000 gpd in the month of maximum use. Water will be withdrawn from sumps in the Upper Patapsco aquifer to lower the water table to facilitate construction of the Charles Station compressor station. The project is located at 6855 Barrys Hill Road, approximately 0.5 mile east of the junction of Marshall Hall and Barrys Hill Roads, Bryans Road, Charles County, Maryland.

County: Dorchester

DO2018G001/01: Lowin Farms LLC has applied to appropriate and use an annual average of 127,000 gallons of groundwater per day (gpd) and an average of 772,000 gpd for crop irrigation. Water will be withdrawn from one well in the Piney Point aquifer. The project is located at 6420 Cabin Creek Road, Hurlock, Dorchester County, Maryland.

HO2018G001/01: Island Companies LLC has applied to appropriate and use an annual average of 10,600 gallons of groundwater per day (gpd) and an average of 17,600 gpd during the month of maximum use for individual supplies at the proposed 29-lot residential subdivision of the Lyhus Property. Water will be withdrawn from 29 wells in the Lower Pelitic Schist of the Wissahickon Formation. The project is located at 12170 Lime Kiln Road, Fulton, Howard County, Maryland.

The project is located on the north side of Old Quantico Road, at its junction with Nanticoke Road, approximately one mile west of Salisbury, Wicomico County, Maryland.
