Table 3: OBIF FY14 Priorities

- 1. Initiate and finalize septic system vendor selection for use by local governments. This IFB is the second three-year procurement initiated by MDE.
- In coordination with the MDE WIP management team, MDP, and the BRF Advisory Committee, develop a priority list of 10 to 15 minor WWTPs for ENR upgrades. Work with those local governments to initiate ENR planning and design, with the goal of having at least 5 of these minor WWTPs upgraded by 2017.
- 3. Publish and implement BRF WWTP & Septic Program implementation regulations.
- 4. Issue BRF revenue bonds by June 30, 2014, contingent on the cash flow needs of the ENR Program.
- 5. Work with administrations to identify resources for the highest priorities, and to the extent possible, to minimize the impacts of sequestration on MDE employees
