Environmental Team

We call our team the Green Tikkun Committee. Tikkun is a Hebrew word that means repair. The Green Tikkun Committee is trying to "repair" the synagogue by increasing its sustainability and reducing or eliminating harm to the environment. Our team is made of volunteers from members of our synagogue. The team has a chair. There is an annual meeting each year and other informal meetings throughout the year as needed.

Environmentally Preferable Purchasing

When disposable foodware items are necessary, we purchase compostable items and put out a well-marked bin so the items will be composted, along with food scraps.

Environmental Restoration and Community Environmental Projects

Once a year, we host an event where our members can drop off their hazardous items for proper disposal. We do not charge to our members.

We use washable dishes, bowls, cups, and utensils at events with food whenever possible.

Recycling

Well-marked recycling bins are located around the building where people would likely need to dispose of these items. We collect the following materials.

Energy Efficiency

We maintain a spreadsheet with the number kWh of electricity used each month. With this data, we have a year-over-year chart that makes it clear when electricity usage is significantly greater than the same month in previous years and investigate and ameliorate the variance as appropriate.

Renewable Energy

We have purchased 100% wind power through our utility. This amounts to approximately 434,000 kWh per year.

Transportation
