- *We have started to install motion sensors on some of our lighting around the facility.*



Renewable Energy

We have our own waste water treatment plant generating biogas which is burned in one of our boilers. Our new combined heat and power (CHP) equipment can burn biogas or natural gas, creating electricity and hot water. We are generating around 381 kWh of energy 24 hrs/day and supplying our plant with water at 125 degrees F.

Part of our first pass non-contact cooling water gets reused in the plant for various processes, such as cleaning.
