printing and client printing, we work with a “low-eco impact” local printer who are members of the EPA Green Power Partners and the Maryland Green Registry, which provides us with soy-based inks and FSC Certified or recycled content papers. In our office, we encourage the use of cleaning products and materials that are non-toxic and environmentally friendly.

*Single-stream recycling is available at our facility. Andana recycles all appropriate materials including plastics, aluminum cans, paper, and cardboard each day. If Andana recycles approximately 50” of stacked paper/cardboard each week, it will result in 751.4 reams of paper being saved each year. We only purchase paper products that contain recycled content.
