Waste

Solid Waste Reduction and Reuse

Our office staff saves documents electronically instead of printing them out. When we do print, we print double-sided documents whenever possible. Over a 4-month period, we reduced the amount of paper purchased from 48 lbs to 24 lbs.

Recycling

A recycling bin for plastic materials is provided in the lobby for customers and office staff. Another recycling bin is provided in the body shop for our technicians and painter.

Energy

Energy Efficiency

Recently, we changed the bulbs in the office, body shop and paint shop to energy efficient light bulbs. Energy usage on the previous electric bill was 21,860 kWh. The most recent bill was for 20,026 kWh, a savings of 1,834 kWh per month or 22,008 kWh annually. Cost savings was \$28/month or \$337 annually.
