Environmentally Preferable Products and Services

We offer a number of earth friendly products including a line of natural mineral makeup and skincare products, clean burning natural wax candles made of soy and palm wax, and gift bags made from TerraSkin, a tree-free paper made from crushed stone that returns to its natural elements when disposed.

Environmentally Preferable Purchasing

We purchase recycled packing material and green cleaning products.

Recycling

We separate and recycle our garbage. It is separated into glass, plastics, cans, paper, disposable (recyclable) packing material and cardboard.

Energy Efficiency

The building has energy efficient double-paned windows and energy efficient lighting. Caulking, insulation, and weather stripping have also been installed to help improve the energy efficiency of the store.

Transportation

Employee Commute

The owners ride together, rather than separately, when traveling from their home to the store, reducing the need for two vehicles. We drive 15 miles and save one gallon of gas per day. This amounts to 264 gallons of annual fuel savings and a 3,276 kg reduction in annual carbon dioxide emissions reductions.

Next year, the owners plan to move to Havre de Grace in order to be close to work and will be able to bicycle or walk to work further reducing fuel usage and our carbon footprint.
