Environmental Team

We have both a Green Team that consists of 20+ members to go along with a Pollution Prevention team that consists of an additional 15 employees. The Green Team meets on a quarterly basis and the Pollution Prevention team meets on a semi annual basis. The Green Team ensures that we follow our strict environmental guidelines and the Pollution Prevention Team keeps us on track to get to Zero Landfill. Since we started this Zero Landfill initiative we have reduced our landfill waste by 16%.

Environmental Policy Statement

Frito-Lay is committed to conducting its business operations in a manner that is consistent with concern and respect for our fragile environment. Toward this end, operational decisions shall reflect our strong belief in sound environmental management and environmental conservation as we faithfully seek to comply with all federal, state, provincial and local environmental laws, rules and regulations.

Annual Environmental Goals

Frito Lay's environmental goals for the next 2 years is the 1-1-1 % philosophy. 1% finished waste (currently 3%) 1% film waste (currently 6%) 1% landfill waste (currently 0.12%)

Environmental Restoration or Community Environmental Projects

Frito Lay Aberdeen owns a section of highway in Aberdeen that we keep clean as part of our adopt a highway program. We are also part of Harford County night in Annapolis. We participate in career day at HCCC as well as Meadowvale Elementary. We are part of the LEPC.

Independently-Audited Environmental Management System

All Frito lay facilities are audited for environmental compliance on an annual basis. Our EMS protocol is very similar to ISO 14001. We have two outside consultants that show up at our plants and spend 3 to 4 days reviewing our program.

Waste

Recycling

In 2014 we recycled aluminum can, scrap metal, bulk bags, stretch film, paper, plastics, cardboard, product waste, ballasts, batteries, cores, cooking oil, film, electronic waste, bulbs, pallets, rags, and tires. After paying all waste bills, we were still able to generate \$ 326,939.26 in revenue that we can put back into our recycling program.
