Recycling

- *All on site packaging materials will be recycled at the client's residence. If they are not compliant with recycling, then the material will be transported to the Annapolis city and/or Anne Arundel county facilities. Cost savings will benefit the refuse volume of the city and/ or county.*
- *All paper and plastic and glass and metals will be recycled.*

Water soluble products will be used on all applications. Oil-based paint products will be used as a primer only to seal water damage. Aggressive paint chemicals for stripping coatings will be avoided.

Energy Efficiency

We have installed a new HVAC system that is 85% efficient. This replaces a system that was 20 years old and operating at approximately 50% efficiency. Projected cost savings of \$840 annually.

We replaced a fleet vehicle that was failing emissions tests with one that is newer and compliant with all emissions standards.
