Environmentally Preferable Procurement

We purchase 100% recycled copy/printer paper, as well as folders, envelopes, cleaning supplies, paper towels, toilet paper, tissues and Post-Its. We also use recycled paper with soy ink for our stationary and business cards. Our beverages are primarily organic products as well (coffee, tea, etc.). Wherever possible, we buy reused, recycled, and/or organic products.

We installed LED bulbs throughout the office saving about 1,300 kWh annually.

Renewable Energy

100% of the power used is generated from wind power through Clean Choice Energy (~500 kWh per month used).

Transportation

Employee Commute

One third of our staff walk to work daily reducing vehicle travel by at least three miles per day, and two thirds of the staff work remotely more than half the time further reducing vehicle travel.

Efficient Business Travel

Travel to DC is done via the MARC train to Union Station and then the Metro while in DC and Northern Virginia.
