Environmentally Preferable Products and Services

Soupergirl (Sara's Soup Inc.) cooks all vegan food. Cooking and consuming vegan food is one of the most impactful ways a company and individual can lower their carbon footprint.

Soupergirl sources many of our vegetables from local farms within the Chesapeake watershed region.

Recycling

Soupergirl is currently recycling approximately 1,700 pounds of cardboard per month. The company is paid a varying rate per bundle as the cardboard is resold. In May, Soupergirl was paid \$60 for the cardboard.

Composting

Soupergirl composts thousands of pounds of vegetable scraps each year in partnership with Compost Cab.

Energy

Energy Efficiency

Soupergirl was recently awarded a grant from the Maryland Energy Administration to replace a cooling process with a highly energy efficient system. Soupergirl is planning an energy audit in conjunction with the [Maryland Manufacturing Extension Partnership](#). With the results of this audit, the company plans on implementing energy reduction plans.
