We use bio-degradable packaging when we need extra protection in shipping.

Environmentally Restoration or Community Environmental Projects

We held an open house at our Hunt Valley facility in July 2010 to showcase our new solar installation and to educate the community about the energy, costs savings and tax benefits associated with these projects.

Waste

Solid Waste Reduction and Reuse

We have approximately 12,000 students enrolled annually at our computer training facilities in Hunt Valley and Columbia. We offer refreshments throughout the day and provide filtered water instead of plastic water bottles.

All cardboard and incoming packing materials are used again rather than buying new materials. When they are beyond their useful life they are recycled.

Recycling

We have recycled office paper and cardboard for the past 15 years.

Energy

Energy Efficiency

By July 2010, we will have replaced all of the T-12 light bulbs in our building with T-8s. This will reduce the power the lights use and the power to operate by 35%.

By July 2010, we will have installed automatic light sensors in the 8 bathrooms in our building to regulate the lighting.

Renewable Energy

In June 2010, we completed the installation of 186 solar panels on our roof that will generate 65 kWh annually, saving us at least \$95,000 annually.
