

Groups collaborated using digital worksheets and consensus-based dialogue to develop *visions, high level goals, and strategies*

CONSENSUS: A TOOL FOR EQUITABLE COLLABORATION

When using consensus to make decisions, the group does not “vote,” which implies a binary response.
