

Overview of the MCCC and Working Group



The Maryland Commission on Climate Change (MCCC)

- MCCC Goal: Provide recommendations on how to reduce GHG emissions and adapt to the impacts of climate change
- Originated in 2007
- Commission codified into law in 2015
 - Made recommendations on the GGRA in December of 2015
 - O GGRA of 2016 signed into law in April 2016
- The Climate Solutions Now Act of 2022 added state climate goals and expanded MCCC membership, including adding four new working groups.



MCCC Working Groups

- Originally had four working groups:
 - The Adaptation and Response (Resilience) Working Group
 - The Scientific and Technical Working Group
 - The Education, Communication and Outreach Working Group
 - The Greenhouse Gas Mitigation Working Group
- Four new working groups due to the CSNA:
 - The Solar Photovoltaic Systems Recovery, Reuse and Recycling Working Group
 - The Just Transition Employment and Retraining Working Group
 - The Energy Industry Revitalization Working Group
 - The Energy Resilience and Efficiency Working Group




