

MCCC ANNUAL REPORT | 2022

Education, Communication and Outreach Working Group Recommendations

1. To meet the tenets of inclusivity and climate justice outlined in the Climate Solutions Now Act, any forthcoming/future legislation on climate change should use short, plain (non-scientific and brief) language in bill titles, goals, and names of commissions, task forces, and working groups.
2. Marylanders must be engaged and invested in achieving the state's goal of reducing GHG emissions and improving resilience. To educate and motivate all Maryland residential and business communities, legislation should be drafted to appropriate \$5 million of funding to develop a statewide awareness campaign, which will include an interactive website that will offer one stop shopping for resources to help Marylanders become part of the climate solution.
