Purpose

 Zero Waste Mason is a collaborative program that aims to reduce campus-wide waste by diverting over 90% if waste away from trash streams.

Coming soon: Indoor waste station standards!

Functions

Waste Diversion

- Manage diversion improvement initiatives and testing.
- Oversee or support Donation, Surplus, and Recovery improvement/initiatives (e.g., Patriot Pack Out (Move Out), food recovery).
- Oversee waste audits, verify data for ZWM.
- Coordinate partnerships and support the development/improvement of specialty recycling, composting, and donation initiatives.
- Support implementation of ZWM Standards & Guidelines developed.

Waste Reduction

- Support George Mason University's "Buy Less, Buy Better" initiative by:
 - Verifying/Inventorying for Plastics Free Mason (single-use plastics reduction).
 - Support Reuse + Refill initiatives and relevant PGF grant proposals.
 - Oversee Move In (reuse) pop-up/ store.




