Weber State University ASE L1 Test Preparation Class

The **FREE** class “**ASE L1 Test Preparation**” will be taught by Utah’s Weber State University on June 7th and 8th 2019 from 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM. **BOTH SESSIONS WILL COVER THE SAME MATERIAL.** The class is being taught at the Homer S. Gudelsky Institute for Technical Education of the Rockville Campus of Montgomery College.

This course is designed to prepare students to take the ASE L1 Advanced Engine Performance Specialist Test. Course content will include ASE L1 specific and ASE general test preparation aids. A discussion of ASE L1 test content, including exhaust gas analysis and emissions failure diagnosis, will be included. ASE test question types and test taking strategies will be covered. L1-specific test details will include discussion of the ASE composite vehicle booklet and its proper use. A sample ASE L1 type practice exam will be included and reviewed.
