**COUNTY SOURCE REDUCTION (SR) CREDIT SUMMARY**  
**For Calendar Year 2017**

The number of shaded boxes illustrates the number of positive responses for each activity. A column does not correspond to any particular county. Each county had a unique combination of SR activities undertaken during the year. The credits awarded are summarized below:

- Counties (Anne Arundel, Baltimore, Carroll, Frederick, Harford, Howard, Montgomery, Prince George’s) received the full 5% credit.
- Counties (Baltimore City, Cecil, Charles) received 4% credit.
- Counties (Allegany, St Mary’s) received 3% credit.
- Counties ( ) received 2% credit.
- Counties (Garrett, Dorchester) received 1% credit.
