The Maryland Department of the Environment, Air and Radiation Administration (ARA) received a complete permit-to-construct application from ARJ Construction Company on June 17, 2020 for the installation of one (1) Powerscreen (Terex) Chieftain 1700 coal screen rated at 200 tons per hour powered by a 111 hp diesel engine. The proposed Powerscreen (Terex) Chieftain 1700 coal screen will be located at Jackson Mountain Coal Mine on Jackson Mountain Road in Lonaconing, Allegany County, Maryland.
