On November 9, 2016, Dominion Energy Cove Point LNG, LP (DECP) submitted an Air Quality Permit to Construct Application regarding DECP's Eastern Market Access (EMA) Project for the proposed Charles Compressor Station located on Barrys Hill Road in Charles County, Maryland. The Air Quality Permit to Construct Application was submitted to Maryland Department of the Environment (MDE) to construct and operate a new natural gas transmission compressor station.
