Biennial Hazardous Waste Reports Due March 1

Biennial hazardous waste reports to the Maryland Department of the Environment are due by March 1, 1998. There are no exceptions to the March 1 filing deadline and waste generators who fail to meet the deadline will be subject to departmental enforcement actions. This will be the first biennial, or every second year, reporting submission since the hazardous waste regulations were revised in 1997. Previously hazardous waste generators had to file on a yearly basis. The biennial report of hazardous waste activity includes information on the generation, treatment, storage, disposal, shipping and receiving of hazardous waste. Although the report is submitted biennially, generators are required to keep track of waste generated for every calendar year. Public Hearing on Air Quality Regulations Scheduled for March

The Maryland Department of the Environment will hold public hearings March 4 on amendments to existing air quality regulations and on new regulations. The public hearings will be held at 10 a.m. at the Maryland State Office Building, 300 West Preston Street, First Floor Auditorium, Baltimore. The actions are listed below and will:

- clarify existing regulations (Regulation .09 under COMAR 26.11.02 Permits, Approvals, and Registration; Regulations .02 and .15 under COMAR 26.11.19 Volatile Organic Compounds from Specific Processes),
- establish VOC content limits for the decorative coating of plastic bottles (Regulation .07 under COMAR 26.11.19 Volatile Organic Compounds from Specific Processes),
- establish Reasonably Available

- Control Technology (RACT) standards for sources that manufacture solid resin decorative surfaces (new Regulation .07-1 under COMAR 26.11.19 Volatile Organic Compounds from Specific Processes),
- establish specific requirements for sources that restore brake shoes (Regulation .13 and new Regulation .13-2 under COMAR 26.11.19 Volatile Organic Compounds from Specific Processes),
 - establish RACT standards for sources that coat large structural steel components (new Regulation .13-3 under COMAR 26.11.19 Volatile Organic Compounds from Specific Processes),
 - establish VOC requirements for digital imaging (Regulation .18 under COMAR 26.11.19 Volatile Organic Compounds from Specific Processes),
 - amend the VOC RACT regulation

- for expandable polystyrene operations (Regulation .19 under COMAR 26.11.19 Volatile Organic Compounds from Specific Processes),
- repeal the Employee Commute Options regulations (COMAR 26.11.25 Employee Commute Options),
 - amend the Conformity regulations (Regulations .01 - .04 under COMAR 26.11.26), and
 - establish a nitrogen oxides (NOx) cap and trade program consistent with the Ozone Transport Commission NOx Memorandum of Understanding (new Regulations .01 - .14 under COMAR 26.11.27 and new Regulations .01 - .13 under COMAR 26.11.28).

Snow Hill Wastewater Treatment Plant - Worcester County

On January 1, 1998, the Town of Snow Hill paid the first installment of the \$25,000 mandatory penalty assessment issued by MDE on March 4, 1997 for significant BOD and TSS effluent violations.

Status: The final payment of \$12,500 is due by July 1, 1998. (Reference # AP-97-0037).

Bardon, Inc. - Montgomery County

On January 7, 1998, MDE issued a unilateral administrative complaint, order and penalty assessment against Bardon, Inc. for NPDES permit violations at the company's concrete readi-mix plant located at 10450 Metropolitan Avenue, Kensington, Maryland. The complaint alleges that Bardon, Inc. failed to implement a storm water pollution prevention plan, unlawfully discharged process wastewater to an unnamed tributary to Rock Creek and failed to collect samples and submit monitoring reports as required under the facility's discharge permits. The order requires Bardon to submit a corrective action plan within 20 days to address effluent violations, monitoring and reporting deficiencies and implementation of a pollution prevention plan. A \$50,000 penalty has been assessed.

Status: The company has ten days to request a hearing on the order and 30 days to appeal the penalty assessment. Case pending. (Reference # AO-98-0036).

David L. Reid - Worcester County

On December 16, 1997, MDE issued an administrative order to Mr. Reid for clearing in a nontidal wetland and its buffer without authorization at the residential property of David and Berlyn Wheeler at Lot 3, West Torquay Road, Ocean Pines in Worcester County. The inspection revealed that clearing in a regulated area had begun prior to receiving nontidal wetland authorization.

Status: The contractor stopped work and removed his equipment from the site. The nontidal wetland approval is pending. (Reference #SC-O-98-0064).

Consolidated Pharmaceutical Products - Anna Arundel County

On January 6, 1998, MDE finalized a Settlement Agreement with this penicillin production facility to resolve violations involving off-site odors generated by the company. The initial enforcement action was reported in an earlier issue. The company has achieved compliance by making changes in their operations and procedures to ensure a future similar event does not occur. The company has also paid a \$7,800 penalty in finalizing the settlement.

Status: Case closed. (Reference # ACP 97-07)

Advanced Graphics - Harford County

On December 17, 1997, MDE issued a Corrective Order to this laser rubber engraving facility for installing a piece of equipment without the applicable air quality permit, creating visible emissions and odors and violating conditions of an existing air quality permit. The order requires the company to achieve compliance by March 31, 1998. MDE is also considering seeking a penalty for the violations.

Status: The company has appealed the order. (Reference # ACP 97-10)

Frederick K. Adams, Jr. - Veterinarian - Montgomery County

In an action taken earlier, Frederick K. Adams, Jr. was ordered to cease using an x-ray machine located at his practice in Silver Spring until deficiencies associated with the machine were corrected. Dr. Adams was also ordered to pay a \$2,000 penalty.

Status: The machine was later rendered inoperable by MDE, and remains so today, as a result of a failure on the part of Dr. Adams to

correct the deficiencies. Dr. Adams has yet to pay the penalty. As a result, a lien has been placed on his property. (Reference # 31-1678)

Browning-Ferris, Inc. - Charles County Site

On January 2, 1998, a complaint order and administrative penalty was issued against Browning-Ferris, Inc. revoking two sewage sludge utilization permits and assessing a \$50,000 administrative penalty against Browning-Ferris, Inc. for violating state sewage sludge utilization regulations. The Company was cited for failing to incorporate sewage sludge into the soil by the end of the working day and uneven spreading of sludge in Charles County. The Company was also cited for failure to maintain a buffer zone distance of 200 feet between the area where sludge was applied and an off-site residence. The sludge was spread by CDR Mid Atlantic of Oxford, Pennsylvania, a Browning-Ferris, Inc. subcontractor. Due to business arrangements, CDR has taken over Browning-Ferris, Inc.'s sludge operations. However, Browning-Ferris retains the permit.

Status: Pending (Reference # CO-AP - 98-SF-035)

Clean Venture, Inc - Anne Arundel County

On January 5, 1998 a notice of violation was issued to Clean venture, Inc. for \$10,000 for improper transportation and management of hazardous waste. In October, 1997 the company transported a shipment of controlled hazardous substances (CHS) to their new base of operations without a valid CHS vehicle certificate for the vehicle prior to transporting the hazardous waste. Additionally, a copy of the CHS hauler certificate was not present in the vehicle. These same infractions were repeated when the company transported CHS to Philadelphia.

Status: Pending (Reference #NOV-98-025)

Integrating Highway Development with Communities and the Environment

A significant evolution is underway to enhance the approach to highway development. This evolution is marked by designs which are more sensitive to community interests and environmental surroundings. These changes are not just led by community and environmental advocates, but by some road designers.
