Settlement will reduce air pollution

Ozone-causing emissions from coal-fired units at three major power plants in Maryland and a fourth plant in Virginia will be reduced by nearly 65 percent – and by over 70 percent during the summer ozone season – under a settlement reached with the Maryland Department of the Environment (MDE) filed Sept. 27.

In a case that also involved the Virginia Department of Environmental Quality and the federal Environmental Protection Agency, Mirant Mid-Atlantic LLC agreed to reduce the amount of nitrogen oxides (NOx) released by its four plants in the Washington, D.C. region starting in 2004. Additional re-

Governor announces new regulations to cover MTBE

Governor Robert L. Ehrlich, Jr., announced new regulations to prevent MTBE and other petroleum products from reaching

groundwater supplies in certain parts of Maryland. The regulations, which will be issued by the Maryland Department of the En-

vironment (MDE) this fall, will require installation of double-walled pipes on all regulated mo-

Storage tank anchoring seminar nears, register

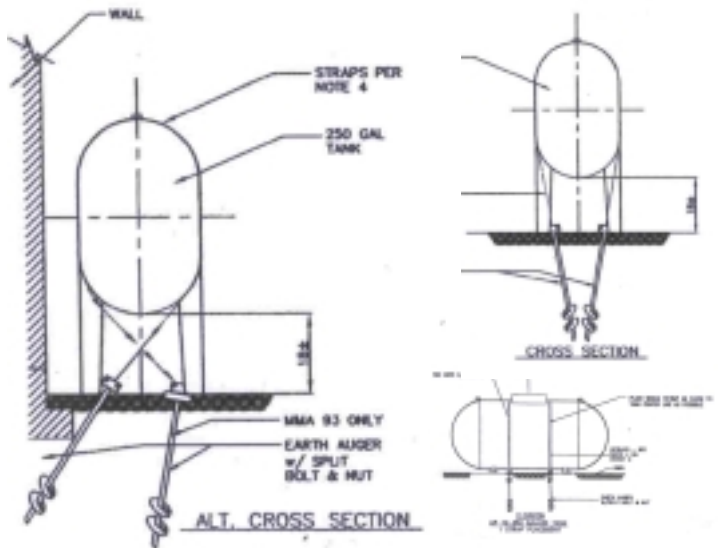
The Maryland Department of the Environment (MDE) will hold two oil and propane tank anchoring events in coming weeks for community members, local officials, anchor suppliers and the oil and propane industry. The events will be held on Oct. 20 and 21 from 9a.m. to 2 p.m. The events will include hands on anchoring lessons, presentations on the importance of anchoring tanks and the opportunity to meet with those in the tank and anchor industry. A barbeque style lunch will be served.

The first tank anchoring session will be held on the Eastern Shore Oct. 20 at the 4-H Park in Queen Anne's County, located off MD Route 18 between Queenstown and Centreville. On Oct. 21 the event will be held at the National Guard Armory on Hudson Street in the Parole section of Annapolis. Those working in the heating oil and propane distribution industries are highly encouraged to attend one of these events.

Propane and oil tank spills are becoming increasingly problematic for Maryland residents. Last year, flooding from Hurricane Isabel dislodged and spilled hundreds of residential oil tanks in Maryland causing the federal and state governments to spend \$15 million in remediation costs. These spills are toxic to people and animals that live in flood prone areas and can result in water contamination, fire, injury and even death.

Maryland is now equipped with several suppliers of tank anchors. Most oil suppliers will install anchors for a small fee. By law, propane deals must anchor any propane tank located in the floodplain. Residents living in the floodplain are encouraged to take all necessary precautions to prevent future oil and propane spills by anchoring their tanks immediately.

Grant to UMBI will fund study of toxins in fish-killing algae

A \$149,660 grant from the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA) will fund projects at the University of Maryland Biotechnology Institute in Baltimore, to study toxin production in fish-killing algae with the aim of better understanding the environmental circumstances that cause organisms to produce the toxins.

The grant from the Ecology and Oceanography of Harmful Algal Blooms program, managed by NOAA Ocean Service will focus on Karlodinium micron, which occurs widely along the east coast of the U.S., and produces at least two fish-killing toxins. The grant will support research to inves-

tigate how and why toxin structure varies between different locations. The research may lead to new insights on reasons why some algae produce toxins, which will assist in developing management strategies.

“Harmful algal blooms are a serious economic and public health problem all over the world. NOAA is working to remove, or at least diminish, the threat of these occurrences to save lives and protect the vital economy of our coasts,” said retired Navy Vice Adm. Conrad C. Lautenbacher, Ph.D., under secretary of commerce for oceans and atmosphere and NOAA administrator. “NOAA and the adminis-

tration are working to improve the understanding of our environment and to strengthen re-

gional initiatives like those run by the University of Maryland Biotechnology Institute.”

The University of Maryland Biotechnology Institute consists of five major research and education centers and is dedicated to advancing the frontiers of biotechnology and its application to human health, the marine environment, agriculture, protein engineering and structural biology. UMBI's centers of research are the Center for Advanced Research in Biotechnology, the Center for Biosystems Research, the Medical Biotechnology Center, the Institute of Human Virology, and the Center of Marine Biotechnology. Dr. Allen Place, a biochemist and professor at UMBI's Center of Marine Biotechnology, will be the principal investigator.

tor fuel underground storage systems and require built-in sensors to warn of leaks.

“For Maryland families that rely on wells,” Governor Ehrlich said, “these new measures will provide additional assurance that their water supplies are clean and safe from MTBE and other petroleum products. These are tough, but necessary regulations to strengthen our environmental laws.”

Pursuant to the federal Clean Air Act, MTBE (methyl tertiary-butyl ether) replaced lead in gasoline in the 1980s and is used to reduce carbon monoxide emissions from vehicles.

MTBE makes important environmental and economic contributions by improving Maryland’s air quality and keeping gas prices affordable.

The emergency regulations will also require increased groundwater sampling, mandate regular testing of tanks and fittings, and define steps that gas station owners and others must take when underground storage systems are suspected of contaminating groundwater.

The regulations, announced Aug. 11, will apply in areas where wells are the primary source of household drinking water and local geology makes it impractical for homeowners to find a new water source. MDE will identify the areas and notify affected tank farm operators.

The regulatory review committee of the General Assembly must review and approve the proposed emergency regulations before they can become effective.

Service stations and other underground storage facilities in areas covered by the regulations will have 30 days after the effective date of the regulations to begin quarterly sampling of water in on-site domestic wells and tank field observation pipes.

They will also be required to conduct annual tightness tests for fittings in catchment basins and containment sumps. Results must be reported to MDE.

If MTBE at levels greater than 20 parts per billion (ppb), more than 5 ppb of benzene or more than 100 ppb of total BETX (benzene, toluene, ethyl benzene and xylenes) are found, the operator will be required to drill three groundwater monitoring wells and submit samples from the new wells to MDE. They will also be required to perform an advanced helium leak detection test, which is used to identify vapor leaks.

In addition to repairing all leaks immediately, the operator will be required to install a soil vapor extraction system in the tank area to remove vapors from the earth or other advanced technology to keep vapors within the tank system.

The MDE regulations also establish a timetable for installing double-walled piping with sensors and alarm systems. Double-walled piping will be required on all new and replacement systems, and systems that are 15 years old or older must be upgraded by January 1, 2006. All systems must be upgraded no later than January 1, 2009.

Since June, MDE has been investigating the presence of MTBE in private wells in the Upper Crossroads area of Harford County. The investigation has focused on an Exxon service station on Fallston Road, where a number of vapor leaks have been found and repaired.

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency has concluded that there is no measurable health effect from low level MTBE exposure. The EPA’s health advisory states that levels of contamination at or below 20 parts per billion provide a large margin of safety from adverse health effects.

algae investigations in waterways of the state each year. Algae are an essential part of the aquatic foodchain. However several species identified in the Chesapeake and coastal bays have the potential to release toxins directly into the water column or bioaccumulate in shellfish under certain conditions. Some of those toxins can have human or animal health consequences. Excess nutrients tend to be a catalyst to dangerous algal blooms.

Each year, NOAA Ocean Service’s Center for Sponsored Coastal Ocean Research, which

manages ECOHAB, awards approximately \$30 million in grants to members of the academic, state and scientific communities to assist NOAA in fulfilling its mission to study our coastal oceans in order to predict environmental change, manage ocean resources, protect life and property, and provide decision makers with reliable and timely scientific information. NOAA-sponsored competitive research programs such as ECOHAB demonstrate NOAA’s commitment to these basic responsibilities of science and service to the nation for the past 34 years.

ductions will be required each year until 2010.

“This agreement will have a substantial impact on the air quality in the entire Washington area,” said Kendl P. Philbrick, Maryland’s secretary of the environment. Reducing air pollution in the Washington, D.C. area will help the region comply with the federal Clean Air Act standards by 2010, Philbrick said.

Under the terms of the agreement:

- Mirant will install state-of-the-art NOx controls on its two coal-fired units at the Morgantown plant, the company’s largest in Maryland. The controls will be fully operational by May 2008. Mirant has also agreed to install NOx controls on three of the units at its Potomac River Plant in Alexandria.

- The company will run the NOx controls year-round, not just during the summertime ozone season, to meet an emissions rate of .10 pounds per million BTUs. Operating the controls year-round will further reduce nitrogen deposition in the

Chesapeake Bay and other Maryland waterways and help the state meet the federal standard for fine particulates.

- Mirant’s coal-fired plants will meet a system-wide ozone season NOx limit of .15 pounds per million BTUs in 2008.

- Over the next six years, Mirant will meet sharply declining ozone season and annual NOx emission tonnage caps.

“We estimate that by 2010 NOx emissions from Mirant’s coal-burning units will be cut by nearly 75 percent during the ozone season and by 65 percent on an annual basis,” Philbrick said. “This is welcome news for the entire region.”

The settlement resolves alleged NOx emissions limit violations at the Potomac River plant during the 2003 ozone season.

The settlement was filed in federal district court in Northern Virginia. Several things must happen before the settlement takes effect. Public comment will be solicited and a federal bankruptcy court in Texas must approve the settlement, as must the federal district court judge.



Air & Radiation Management Administration

Coastal Supply Company - Wicomico County—On June 14, MDE received payment of \$4,000 from Coastal Supply as required by a recently signed Consent Order to resolve violations of air quality regulations. The action was based on four Notices of Violation issued by MDE to Coastal Supply for dust emissions and air pollution nuisance violations. The dust was emanating from Coastal Supply's property and falling on a residential area nearby. The residents were registering complaints with MDE's Eastern Shore Regional Office. In addition to paying the penalty, Coastal Supply improved its operations in order to eliminate dust emissions. Coastal Supply is now operating in compliance with air quality requirements. Status: Case Closed. (Reference #AQCP 031004)

Ethel Mae Holmes – Norfolk, VA—On June 24, MDE's previously issued Notice of Revocation and Order to Ethel Mae Holmes, president of Holmes Environmental, Inc. became a Final Order. The 30-day deadline had passed for Ms. Holmes to request a hearing and she failed to respond to the previously issued Order, which required her to cease all the activities for which she has accreditation, return all certificates and photo ID cards in

her possession, and provide a list of asbestos projects that she handled in Maryland. The Revocation and Order were originally issued by MDE because Ms. Holmes used fraudulent certificates from a Virginia-based training provider to obtain asbestos training and accreditation in Maryland. Additionally, she was found guilty in federal court on March 23rd on all counts of an indictment including use of the certificates that she used in Maryland to obtain further training. Status: Ms. Holmes to be sentenced on October 29th. (Reference #AP 04-01-02REV)

Consultative Examinations, Inc. – Baltimore City—On July 1, MDE and Consultative Examinations signed a Consent Order with an \$800 penalty to resolve the Complaint, Order, and Administrative Penalty issued by MDE to Consultative Examinations for failing to renew registration of a radiation machine facility within the prescribed timeframe. Status: Case Closed. (Reference #RHP 04-00)

Allan C. Johnson, DMD – Prince George's County—On July 6, MDE and Dr. Johnson signed a Consent Order with an \$800 penalty to resolve the Complaint, Order, and Administrative Penalty issued by MDE to Dr. Johnson for failure to renew registration of a radiation machine facility within the prescribed timeframe. Status: Case Closed. (Reference #RHP 04-01)

Comprehensive Orthopedic Services and Sports Medicine Center - Charles County—On July 6, MDE and Comprehensive Orthopedic Services signed a Consent Order with a \$7,500 penalty to resolve the Complaint, Order, and Administrative Penalty issued by MDE to Comprehensive Orthopedic Services and Sports Medicine Center for failure to certify a radiation machine and for its continued use while uncertified. Status: Case Closed. (Reference #RHP 03-05)

Belle Grove Corporation and Patuxent Rock – Baltimore City—On July 28, MDE received payment of a \$25,000 administrative penalty assessed against Belle Grove Corporation and Patuxent Rock. The payment was required by a Consent Order entered into with MDE to settle violations of air quality permit requirements. Belle Grove and Patuxent constructed and operated two concrete crushers and associated classifying screens without first obtaining permits to construct and permits to operate from the Department. Since settlement of the case, MDE has issued permits for the crushing operation. Status: Case Closed. (Reference #AQCP 040727)

Franklin Square Hospital – Baltimore County—On July 30, MDE issued a Notice of Proposed Civil Penalty to Franklin Square Hospital in the amount of \$32,500 for violating air quality regulations. Franklin Square operates a medical waste incinerator subject

to state and federal air quality requirements. Franklin Square violated air quality requirements by operating its incinerator for seven days with its bypass stack open, allowing uncontrolled emissions to escape. The Hospital also charged waste into the incinerator at a higher rate than allowed by the regulations. Status: Franklin Square has 10 days to request a meeting on the Penalty. (Reference #AQCP 0408)

Air Products Polymers, L.P. (Air Products)— Cecil County— On August 11, MDE issued a Notice of Proposed Civil Penalty in the amount of \$14,000 to Air Products for air quality violations. Air Products operates an emulsion manufacturing facility that is a major source of volatile organic compounds, making it subject to certain permitting regulations. MDE issued a permit to the Company in May 2000. Based on an evaluation of required reports submitted by the Company, MDE determined that the Company had not conducted monitoring and record keeping for its equipment as required by its permit. The violations occurred over a period of several months. Monitoring and record keeping are required components of the permit to ensure compliance with air quality emission standards. Status: Air Products has 10 days to request a meeting on the Penalty. (Reference #AQCP 0413)

Inc. – Baltimore County

On August 13, MDE issued a Notice of Proposed Civil Penalty in the amount of \$25,000 to Lafarge Building Materials. Lafarge's Sparrows Point plant processes slag from the adjacent ISG blast furnace to produce slag cement. The facility's permit requires periodic visible emissions observations on various processes. An MDE inspection discovered many of the observations were not being performed as required by Lafarge's permit.

Status: Lafarge has 10 days to request a meeting on the Penalty. (Reference #AQCP 0407)

Water Management Administration

Anne Arundel County Department of Public Works – Anne Arundel County – On June 28, MDE and Anne Arundel County Department of Public Works finalized an administrative consent order regarding improvements to the Anne Arundel County sanitary sewer system to address sanitary sewer overflows (SSOs). Under the terms of the consent order, Anne Arundel County has agreed to perform a Capacity, Management, Operation and Maintenance (CMOM) Program, a System Evaluation and Capacity Assurance Plan and an Overflow Emergency Response Plan to properly manage, operate and maintain its sewer collection system to provide adequate capacity to convey base and peak flows and to prevent SSOs and mitigate adverse impact to public health and to waters of the State. The County has also agreed to pay \$18,000 to the Maryland Clean Water Fund and to expend a minimum of \$81,600 to complete a Supplemental Environmental Project (SEP). The consent order also

establishes stipulated penalties for reported SSOs. Status: Case closed. (Reference # CO-04-0135).

Baltimore City Department of Public Works – Baltimore City – On July 7, the Baltimore City Department of Public Works paid a stipulated penalty of \$38,875 to the Maryland Clean Water Fund to resolve reported sanitary sewer overflows (SSOs) during the period July 1 – December 31, 2003 in accordance with the provisions of the federal/State Civil Consent Decree JFM02CVA1524. Status: Case closed. (Reference # SP-04-0131).

Carroll County Department of Public Works – Carroll County – On June 9, MDE and the Carroll County Department of Public Works finalized a settlement agreement whereby Carroll County agreed to pay \$14,500 to the Maryland Clean Water Fund to resolve past NPDES permit violations at the Freedom District Water Treatment Plant. Status: Case closed. (Reference #PS-04-0129).

Water and Sediment Pollution Penalties – Statewide

During the period June 15, 2004 to July 15, MDE collected an additional \$840 to the Sediment Fund in resolution of alleged erosion and sediment control/sediment pollution violations from one site and \$8,125 to the Clean Water Fund in resolution of alleged water pollution violations at three facilities.

Dominic Joseph Perini, Washington County – On July 13, Dominic J. Perini pled guilty before Judge Donald E.

Beachley in the Washington County Circuit of one count of performing construction without an approved sediment control plan, in violation of §§ 4-105(a)(3) and 4-116(a) of the Environment Article, *Annotated Code of Maryland*. Judge Beachley placed Mr. Perini on one-year unsupervised probation before judgment with the following conditions: (1) Defendant must remove an unauthorized bridge; (2) pay \$4,000 penalty and court costs (\$2,000 to the Sediment Control Fund and \$2,000 to Washington County); and (3) pay \$10,000 to the Chesapeake Bay Foundation for a Supplemental Environmental Project. This case was prosecuted by the Office of the Attorney General's Environmental Crimes Unit following referral by MDE's Water Management Administration. Status: Case closed. (Reference # 21-K-04-33133).

Town of Manchester, Carroll County – On July 30, MDE and the Town of Manchester finalized an administrative consent order regarding alleged violations of the reporting and effluent limitation requirements established in State Discharge Permit 00-DP-0642 issued to the Manchester Waste Water Treatment Plant. Under the terms of the Consent Order, the Town of Manchester has agreed to perform improvements to the treatment plant in accordance with an approved plan and time schedule and to pay an administrative penalty of \$17,125 to the Maryland Clean Water Fund. Status: Case closed. (Reference # CO-05-0008).

Hernwood Landfill, Baltimore County – On July 28, MDE issued an administrative Complaint, Order & Penalty against Baltimore County for alleged solid waste and water pollution violations at the

Hernwood Sanitary Landfill located in Granite, Maryland. The Order requires Baltimore County to submit to MDE's Waste Management Administration plans for completion of the landfill capping project and to submit to MDE's Water Management Administration plans for improvements to the landfill's leachate treatment system to address alleged violations of the ammonia effluent limitations established in State Discharge Permit 94-DP-2635. The Department is seeking an administrative penalty of \$50,000 in this case. Status: Baltimore County has filed an appeal in this case. Settlement negotiations have been initiated. (Reference # AO-05-0007; #C-O-AP-05-SW-006).

Water and Sediment Pollution Penalties – Statewide

During the period July 15 to August 15, MDE collected an additional \$3,900 to the Sediment Fund in resolution of alleged erosion and sediment control/sediment pollution violations from two sites and \$3,150 to the Clean Water Fund in resolution of alleged water pollution violations at three facilities.

Waste Management Administration

Roger Dickson and Rhonda Dickson – 10 affected properties – Baltimore County – was issued Complaint, Order and Civil Penalty equaling \$15,000 on July 27, for violating Maryland's Lead Laws by failing to register a pre-1950 rental property and failing to obtain risk reduction certificate(s) of lead inspection compliance.
