**Comment Response Document
Regarding the Total Maximum Daily Loads of Bacteria for the Impaired Recreational
Areas in Marley Creek and Furnace Creek of Baltimore Harbor Basin in Anne Arundel
County, Maryland**

The Maryland Department of the Environment (MDE) conducted a public review of the proposed Total Maximum Daily Loads (TMDLs) of Bacteria for the Impaired Recreational Areas in Marley Creek and Furnace Creek of Baltimore Harbor Basin in Anne Arundel County, Maryland. The public comment period was open from June 22, 2010 through July 21, 2010. MDE received no written comments.

Changes were made to Section 2.4 Source Assessment; the Point Source subsection, Section 4.7 Load Allocations and Percent Reductions; NPDES Regulated Stormwater subsection, Assurance of Implementation; Existing Funding and Regulatory Framework subsection, and Appendix C was added, based on information received during the public review period internally from MDE - Water Management Administration's (WMA) Permitting Division.
