201861760/18-NT-0323: MD Solar 1, LLC., 800 Bickell Avenue, Suite 100 Miami, Florida, 33131 has applied to construct a 32.5 Megawatt, fixed-tilt solar panel array to provide energy to Georgetown University. The project will include site clearing and grubbing of approximately 249 acres, the installation of modular solar panels, access and maintenance roads, an electrical substation, overhead connection lines, security fence and screening landscaping. The project will permanently impact 15,670 square feet of the nontidal wetlands 25 foot buffer, 40 linear feet of stream and convert 4,550 square feet of palustrine forested wetland to emergent wetland. The project will also temporarily impact 22 linear feet of stream. The project area is within the Wards Run watershed, which includes two Tier II stream segments designated as high quality waters. No mitigation is currently required. The project is located at 4850 Shugart Valley Place, La Plata in Charles County.
