DESCRIPTION OF CERTIFIED PROJECT:

For the vertical and lateral (landward) expansion of the existing Cox Creek Dredged Material Containment Facility (DMCF). This work is necessary to provide additional dredged material placement capacity to maintain safe shipping lanes into and out of the Baltimore Harbor. The work includes raising the existing dikes at the DMCF and the lateral and vertical expansion of the dike around the adjacent upland area of the property. The project includes the construction of approximately 12,140 linear feet of elevated perimeter dike to +60 feet Mean Lower Low Water (MLLW). The perimeter dike will be constructed of either borrow material from the project site or imported material. The work will include the construction of new stormwater outfalls (tidal and nontidal). The lateral (landward) expansion work will result in permanent impacts to 50,530 square feet (1.16 acres) of emergent nontidal wetlands and 101,060 square feet (2.32 acres) of 25-foot nontidal wetland buffer. The project is adjacent the Patapsco River (Use I and II).

A COPY OF THIS REQUIRED CERTIFICATION HAS BEEN SENT TO THE CORPS OF ENGINEERS. THE CERTIFICATION HOLDER SHALL COMPLY WITH THE CONDITIONS LISTED BELOW.

1. If the Department determines that State water quality standards or other appropriate requirements of state law or regulation are not being met, or that State or federal law is being violated, or that further conditions are necessary to assure compliance with such standards, requirements, or laws, the Department may reevaluate and revise this Certification to include conditions appropriate to assure compliance with such standards, requirements, and laws.

Site inspection may be necessary to ensure that limits, methods, and other requirements are met to ensure that water quality standards are met and designated uses are maintained.

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6. The Certification Holder shall obtain any and all additional authorizations or approvals, including self-certifying General Permits issued by MDE, and shall comply with all conditions of such authorizations.

Statement of Necessity for Condition: The condition is necessary to ensure that water quality standards are met and to maintain designated uses of waters.

Statement of Necessity for Condition: This condition is necessary to qualify the period of applicability of the terms and conditions of this Certification to be protective of Maryland water quality standards.


