PG2019G001/01: Washington Suburban Sanitary Commission has applied to appropriate and use an annual average of 131,200 gallons of groundwater per day (gpd) and an average of 309,000 gpd in the month of maximum use to lower the water table for the demolition and construction of a new bio-solids processing plant. Water will be withdrawn from sumps and excavations in the Pleistocene Series Sediments. The project is located at the Piscataway Wastewater Treatment Plant, 1100 Farmington Road, Accokeek, Prince George's County, Maryland.
