DO2020G003/01: William F. Outten, III has applied to appropriate and use an annual average of 145,000 gallons of groundwater per day (gpd) and an average of 881,000 gpd during the month of maximum use for crop irrigation. Water will be withdrawn from two wells in the Columbia aquifer. The project is located at 5210 Indiantown Road, Vienna, Dorchester County, Maryland.

KE2019G003/01: Kings Grant Farm, Inc. has applied to appropriate and use an annual average of 164,000 gallons of groundwater per day (gpd) and an average of 998,500 gpd during the month of maximum use for crop irrigation. Water will be withdrawn from up to seven wells in the Aquia aquifer. The project is located at 6584 Kings Grant Lane, Chestertown, Kent County, Maryland.
