CO2021S006/01: Possum Hill Farms, Inc. has applied to appropriate and use an annual average of 106,000 gallons of surface water per day and a maximum daily withdrawal of 864,000 gallons for crop irrigation at the Gene Robinson property. Water will be withdrawn from an intake in Smithville Lake. The project is located at 6672 Noble Road, Federalsburg, Caroline County, Maryland.

SM1967G103/03: Commissioners of Leonardtown has applied to increase an existing allocation from an annual average of 750,000 gallons of groundwater per day (gpd) and an average of 1,100,000 gpd in the month of maximum use to 1,138,000 gpd and 1,594,000 gpd, respectively. The water will be withdrawn from one existing well and one new well in the Upper Patapsco aquifer for the Town of Leonardtown community water system. The project is located at 23330 Greenbrier Road and at 0.2 miles northwest of the intersection between Greenbrier Road and Joanne Drive, Leonardtown, St. Mary's County, Maryland.
