

While Maryland remains committed, the national context for the ACCII and ACT programs has changed significantly.

Key Development | May 2025

U.S. Congress voted to rescind states' authority to enforce ACCII and ACT programs under the Congressional Review Act (CRA).

The bill was signed into law and is now under litigation.
