The Maryland Department of the Environment (MDE), Land and Materials Administration, has scheduled an informational meeting on an application for a new Controlled Hazardous Substance (CHS) Transfer Facility Permit submitted by Triumvirate Environmental (Baltimore), LLC. The facility would be operated at 1500 Carbon Avenue, Baltimore, MD 21226.

The application seeks a CHS permit for the truck-to-truck transfer of in-transit containerized hazardous waste. The operation would supplement similar activity conducted by the applicant nearby at 3200 Sun Street under an existing CHS Transfer Facility Permit.

The meeting will be held at 6:30 PM Monday August 26, 2024, in the social hall of St. John Lutheran Church, 226 Washburn Avenue, Brooklyn, MD 21225. The informational meeting will be held in connection with the August meeting of Concerned Citizens for a Better Brooklyn.
