Notice of Permit Application Received and
Opportunity to Request an Information Meeting

The Maryland Department of the Environment (MDE), Land and Materials Administration, is currently reviewing an application for a new Controlled Hazardous Substance (CHS) Transfer Facility Permit submitted by Triumvirate Environmental (Baltimore), LLC. The facility would be operated at 1500 Carbon Avenue, Baltimore, MD 21226.

The application seeks a CHS permit for the truck-to-truck transfer of in-transit containerized hazardous waste. The operation would supplement similar activity conducted by the applicant nearby at 3200 Sun Street under an existing CHS Transfer Facility Permit.

Upon written request, the Department will schedule an informational meeting for the purpose of discussing the application and the Department's permit review process. Representatives for the applicant and the Department will be available to answer specific questions. The Department will provide an interpreter for hearing impaired persons, upon written request. Written requests for an informational meeting should be submitted to the Department by the close of business on June 14, 2024.
