

Lead Rental Certification and Accreditation

Submit Accreditation Application for Risk Assessor (RA) - Initial









Accreditation means recognition by the Department that a contractor, supervisor, inspector, risk assessor, training provider, or training course is in compliance with the applicable requirements. Regulations pertaining to accreditation requirements are found in Code of Maryland Regulation (COMAR) 26.16.01

May perform all the functions of a VI and IT. Risk Assessors may also perform Lead Hazard Screenings and Risk Assessments. Risk Assessors may identify lead hazards and make recommendations from analysis of X-ray testing, paint chips, dust, soil, water and questionnaires. Risk Assessors may also perform testing for Clearance.





An application is required to be submitted for review by the Lead Poisoning Prevention Program for approval of accreditation. It is required to be submitted on Lead Rental Certification and Accreditation (LRCA) Database. See the following prerequisites before applying for a Lead Paint Risk Assessor accreditation:

- Required to have held an accreditation/license for Lead Paint Inspector Technician for at least one year.
- Take and pass the 3rd party exam for Risk Assessor (there is a \$35 exam fee due prior to applying for accreditation)
- List of 20 properties where lead-based paint inspections have been conducted (see next slide for details)
- If your experience is from another state, upload a copy of your out of state Lead Paint License(s) into the application

*Paper applications are not longer accepted





List of Inspection Experience - required to complete a list that you conducted while appropriately accredited. One of the following formats is required:

List 20 different lead-based paint inspections

OR

List 5 different lead-based paint inspections and list 15 different dust inspections

You will be required to indicate the date of inspection, the full property address where the inspection was conducted as well as what type of inspection each entry was by specifying what kind of sample was taken:

- Lead-based paint inspection samples: X-Ray Fluorescence Analyzer (XRF) or Paint chip
- **Dust inspection samples: Dust wipe**
