MDE Inspector Orientation Course

What You Need to Know

The Inspector Orientation Course is required for individuals that apply to become a Maryland certified Underground Storage Tank (UST) System Inspector and for individuals that apply to renew an existing UST System Inspector certification. Before an applicant can sit to take the Maryland UST System Inspector Test, the applicant must submit verifiable proof that they successfully completed the Inspector Orientation Course (among other requirements).

Virtual Inspector Orientation Course

The UST System Inspector Orientation Course is a one-day virtual training. The orientation starts at 9:00 a.m. using Google Meet. Attendees are required to keep their cameras on and participate in several quizzes throughout the training.
