- Founded in August 2020, Love & Cornbread works to improve food equity in the most severely underserved areas of Baltimore City by providing residents with delicious ready-to-eat meals made from scratch
- We serve our guests the same food we would serve them if they were guests in our home





Our Impact on Food Inequity

- Since our founding in August 2020, we have provided more than 40,000 delicious, healthy homemade meals to the residents of Penn North
- We serve 400+ meals at three different locations every week
- We have not missed a single Saturday of service in Penn North in more than three years



Why Ready-to-Eat Meals Matter

- Many community members told us that they lack kitchen access, basic utilities, etc. so produce boxes aren't helpful
- Our guests also frequently asked for additional meals for their neighbors
- We now supply these community helpers with weekly deliveries of readyto-eat meals that they can distribute to their network





So What Else? Partnership

- We receive 1,000+ lbs of produce weekly from SWE that our volunteers and chefs transform into delicious, readyto-eat meals
- SWE makes our work possible by providing food at no cost
- We take on the labor of creating meals from donated produce and serve it back up to the community with love
